To ensure that seeds borrowed from the seed library will be well-labelled, please fill in a form for every kind of seed you donate and bring the seed in a sealed envelope with the form inside to any branch of Red Deer Public Library. Please fill in what you can. Fields marked * are required to be filled in for the seed to be accepted.

The library accepts donations of open pollinated seeds like beans, peas, lettuce and tomatoes as well as other types of seeds that are easy to save and adapted to urban spaces, particularly if they are adapted to the Red Deer area, or have ties to this community.

Seed Donation Requirements

please check that seed meets all these requirements

- O seed saved within the past 2 years
- Seed saved from parent plant that is open pollinated
- O seed saved from parent plant that was grown organically
- Seed is clean and dry
- O seed was saved from healthy plants for disease resistance
- O seed was saved from a number of plants for genetic diversity

Ways You Prevented Cross-pollination

- O planted one variety per family in garden
- O followed recommended isolation distance
- O pollinated by hand
